


GET TO KNOW

KURRINDA ON THE TRACK

SATIN STILETTO 30/II WARWICK FARM 740M TRIAL 3RD/5

Satin Stiletto stepped out to the trials for the first time in her career after pleasing her trainer Matthew Dale in her work at home. She continued to step up and tick all the boxes, as always, especially with these 2-year-olds who are still only babies. We will always be guided by the horse, but Satin Stiletto let us know it was time for her to step out at the trials. She showed a very professional attitude in the trial, jumping well. She sat three wide and travelled well, cruising into the home straight only beaten I.66l. Jockey Tyler Schiller didn't ask too much of her, going to the line well under a hold. A very promising trial.

BOSTON ROCKS 30/II NEWCASTLE 950M TRIAL IST/9

Boston Rocks made his much-anticipated return to the trials at his local Newcastle track under jockey Mitchell Bell. He pinged the gates putting himself right outside the leader. They quickly put a few lengths on the rest of the field. On turning into the home straight, Boston's ears pricked, went by the leader with ease. He showed a high cruising speed and never came out of 2nd gear, setting the fastest trial time for the day in the process. He has come back physically even stronger and is in for a very exciting prep.



SOVEREIGN DANE 30/II NEWCASTLE 950M TRIAL 3RD/8

Sovereign Dane rounded out a busy day at the trials for the team as he stepped out for his second trial this preparation. He jumped fairly, jockey Mitchell Bell used his good barrier to find the lead easily. He travelled very kindly and wasn't asked for much of an effort, finishing third in a bunched finish to set him up nicely to head to the races.

SOVEREIGN DANE 16/12 NEWCASTLE 1350M 4TH/9

Sovereign Dane got his prep underway over the I350m at Newcastle, a trip shorter than his ideal distance but a good starting point for his prep to kick off. A tricky barrier was always going to prove a challenge but he jumped well under jockey Mitchell Bell who sent him forward looking for the lead. Unfortunately, the rank outsider decided to kick up and pester us for the lead. With no let up in the blistering sectionals, it was always going to be a task to have a kick in the finish. In saying that, he was very brave in staying on for 4th when you consider the leader dropped right out to be beaten over 15 lengths. A pass mark for his first run this prep and we are sure he will take a lot of improvement from this. He will no doubt benefit from finding a race that isn't run at such crazy sectionals.



SATIN STILETTO 09/I2 EAGLE FARM 1000m 3RD/9

Satin Stiletto stepped out at Eagle Farm to make her racecourse debut in the Listed Calaway Gal Stakes over 1000m, the same race we won last year with Malaboom. She went to the races in great order, and despite her price, we felt she was a genuine top-3 chance. Partnered by jockey Damien Thornton, she jumped fairly and was put into a nice spot behind the leaders. As they turned into the home straight, she got boxed in with Damien having to switch her to the outside to get a clear run. Once she balanced up, she hit the line beautifully and fought all the way to the line to hold down 3rd spot and secure that elusive black type for her pedigree. She already has a pedigree that has received significant updates from her Group I-placed half-brother, I Am Unstoppable. Satin Stiletto has provided her ownership group with a huge return on their investment already, with her value skyrocketing. She is a filly who looks to have a bright future ahead of her both on and off the track. She was expertly presented by the Matthew Dale team. She is now enjoying a well deserved spell after a fantastic first prep. Congratulations to all her ownership group.



SATIN STILETTO 3RD PLACE LISTED CALAWAY GAL STAKES



BOSTON ROCKS 16/12 ROYAL RANDWICK 1100m IST/10

Boston Rocks made his return for the prep off the back of just one very impressive trial win we felt this race suited him well to bypass a 2nd trial and head straight to the races. This would be a step up in grade and his first attempt at Saturday grade in Sydney, he drew a great barrier and with leading Sydney jockey Tim Clark on board we felt the race mapped beautifully for him. Boston jumped well and got a great spot behind the leaders. He travelled smoothly throughout as they got to the 400m mark, and Tim angled him out still under a hard hold with 300m to go Tim got to work on Boston who quickly asserted hitting the front to score by 0.57 of a length, but was never in doubt and value for a lot more considering it was his first try at Saturday grade and going there off the back of just one lead up trial. He will take a lot of improvement from the 1st up run. Tim Clark gave him a 10/10 ride and was full of praise for this exciting galloper who looks to have a very bright future ahead of him. Congratulations to everyone involved in him and a massive thank you to the Nathan Doyle stable for having him spot on.





A GUINEA 22/12 WARWICK FARM 816m TRIAL 5th/8

It was great to see the lightly raced A Guinea return to the trials after almost a year off due to injury. We have shown a great deal of patience with this 4-year-old who boasts an impressive record of 2 wins from just 6 starts to date and has shown he still retains plenty of ability after his trial under jockey Tim Clark. A Guinea was given a very quiet time in the trial and not asked to do much. He travelled beautifully and showed a lot of zest, indicating he is loving being back in work. This was his first trial for his new trainer David Pfieffer who has done a great job with his rehabilitation. He has come out of the trial well and will look for a second trial before getting back to the races.

SUPER NORWEST 28/12 ORANGE 1010M 4th/10

Super Norwest kicked off her campaign with a tricky assignment due to the lack of races in the upcoming program to suit and having to contend with a tricky barrier. Bearing that in mind, she ran huge considering. In a race with plenty of speed on, Jockey Louise Day did the right thing in taking her back. She settled well and although not the most straight forward run home, she flew down the outside running a super last 600m to finish 4th only beating 2.45 lengths. Another stride and she finishes 2nd. This was definitely her most tractable run to date and leaves us excited to see her step up to the IIO0m next start where we are sure she will be hard to hold out. Great first-up run and will take plenty of improvement from that. She is in for an exciting prep for her group of owners.
