KURRINDA ON THE TRACK

SOVEREIGN DANE 3/2 NEWCASTLE 1500M 7th/9

Sovereign Dane was looking to go back-to-back at the Newcastle track, but things didn't quite go to plan. He was well in the market as you'd expect after a good last start win and partnered this time by jockey Koby Jennings. Sovereign jumped well and found the front without too much trouble but unfortunately, this is where things went downhill. Koby elected to allow Sovereign to push forward under no pressure for the lead, setting what can only be described as blistering "Group I" level sectionals unnecessarily, which left nothing in the tank when it came to the straight, a very disappointing run through no fault of the horse and a complete forgive!

SUPER NORWEST 10/2 ROYAL RANDWICK 1200M 5th/17

Super Norwest went to Royal Randwick to tackle a very competitive Highway and is looking to back up her impressive last start win with promising young jockey Olivia Chambers retaining the ride. Jumping fair, Super Norwest rushed through to take a handy position behind a hot tempo. She was keen throughout the run, which can then lead to them lacking a kick in the finish. In saying that, she showed a lot of heart and was right there with a winning chance, outrunning her odds of \$5I, only getting tired in the last 50m to get beaten by some in-form horses. With the form already being well and truly boosted, Super Norwest was beaten by less than 2 lengths at her first try at this grade, a huge effort, and no doubt she is right up to this level. She is now having a well-earned spell after a great prep, exciting times ahead for her ownership group.

QUEENS RHAPSODY 26/2 WARWICK FARM TRIAL 800M 4TH/8

Queen's Rhapsody stepped out for her debut racecourse trial. Despite being a So You Think, she always showed us signs of being quite forward and precocious, so it was no surprise to see her make it to the trials this prep. Jockey Adam Hyeronimus was full of praise post-trial for how she acquitted herself. Jumping slow, she showed plenty of natural speed to muster and rail. She wasn't a big fan of the kickback but didn't let that hold her back. Showing her toughness in the straight, she travelled nicely. When Adam gave her a little squeeze, the response was immediate. She was only beaten 2 lengths by some more experienced rivals, with a bob of the head in it for second place. What was most impressive was the way in which she hit the line. 50m after the post, she was right beside the winner and looking for further. She is a filly that looks to have considerable ability, much like her older brother Boston Rocks. She will now have a well-earned break and will take a lot from this preparation. Very exciting times ahead for all of her ownership group.



HALF CROWN 28/2 DOOMBEN 1350M 3RD/12

Half Crown resumed for a great first-up run. This horse is just so honest, he doesn't know how not to try every time he steps out. With the ground on the dry side for his liking, he still ran a fantastic race for his ownership group. Jumping well, he sat in a nice position three back on the rail under jockey Michael Rodd. Half Crown travelled well throughout the run. He got a split down the fence and was very brave; getting headed by the swoopers down the outside, he fought back to claim 3rd. He has now placed at metropolitan grade, not bad for a \$5k yearling purchase. He has always been Sean's favourite horse to have around the farm and cements his claim to that with another great run. He looks in for a big prep for his owners.

PEDIGREE: This filly is by the multiple worldwide Group I winning stallion So You Think, a dual winner of the Cox Plate, sire of 55 stakes winners and II individual group I winners to date, he is arguably one of Australia's leading sires for a number of years now. She is out of the well related Exceed and Excel winning mare Bellevue Girl, herself a full sister to the Group 3 and stakes winning 2 year old winner Sugar Babe. This filly has a fantastic pedigree and holds great residual value being a half sister to the Group 3 winning and Group 2 Todman stakes runner up Bellevue Hill.

TYPE: She is a very well balanced filly who moved with great ease. She is a very athletic elegant type that posses class in abundance and is a real queen, a must have for those with residual value in mind.

NURSERY: She comes off the great Segenhoe Stud nursery the leading producer of stakes horses over the past 5 years in Australia.

TRAINER: This filly will be trained by David Pfieffer out of the state of the art Warwick Farm, Sydney facilities where she will be given every chance. David Pfieffer has already had great success with the progeny of So You Think including \$2.2 million earner Rocketing By.

NURSERY: She comes off the great farm of Glenlogan Park who produced the 2024 Inglis Millennium and \$400k Pink Bonus winner Fully Lit.

TRAINER: She will be trained by Matthew Dale out of his state of the art Goulburn facilities and will get every chance.

BONUS: This Filly is eligible for the Inglis race series, BOBS bonus scheme and Pink Bonus Scheme.



CASTELVECCHIO X RAKITNO FILLY

Why we purchased her?

PEDIGREE: This Filly is by Arrowfield Stud's exciting young stallion Castelvecchio, a multiple Group I winner on the track. He was an excellent winner of the Inglis Millennium before going on to win the Group I Champagne Stakes, he would go on to even greater heights in his 3yo season winning the Group I Rosehill Guineas before running 2nd in the Cox Plate as a 3yo at weight for age. Rakitno is by champion sire Not A Single Doubt, a winner herself a I200m she possessed plenty of speed and is a ½ sister to the 2yo winning stakes placed Zellindi.

TYPE: This Filly reminded us an awful lot of her dam sire Not A Single Doubt, she was well put together, a great shape, well balanced, athletic and very much in the mould of what he threw throughout his career at stud.

NURSERY: This Filly comes off Rheinwood Pastoral, in recent times Rheinwood have produced the highly exciting colt Libertad a winner of the Group 3 Widden Kindergarten Stakes at 2 and the Group 3 San Domenico highlighting their ability to produce top class racehorses to compete at the highest level.

TRAINER: This Filly will be trained by David Pfieffer out of the state of the art Warwick Farm, Sydney facilities where she will be given every chance.

BONUS: This Filly is eligible for the lucrative Inglis race series and BOBS bonus scheme.



TORONADO X SWIFT SIS FILLY

Why we purchased her?

PEDIGREE: This Filly is by Swettenham Stud's dual Group I winning sire Toronado, as a stallion he is in red hot form, already the sire of 6 individual Group I winners and 34 individual Stakes winners worldwide, including 3 individual Group I winners in Australia. Her dam is the Stakes placed mare Swift Sis a winner of no less than 9 races earning over \$300k on the track from IIOO-I4OOm, she was a very speedy mare in her time and is well related being a I/2 sister to the Group 3 winner Quick Feet.

TYPE: This Filly is a proper athlete very forward and precocious type, she is a great size for a first foal, well put together but it was her walk that we fell in love with. She was one of the best moving horses we have seen this year and one that we were not leaving the sale without.

NURSERY: She comes off the great Makybe Stud, a farm that needs no introduction having produced the 3 time winning Melbourne Cup superstar mare Makybe Diva as multiple worldwide Group I winner and stallion Starspangledbanner.

TRAINER: She will be trained by Matthew Dale at his state of the of the art facilities in Goulburn so she will get every opportunity.

BONUS: This Filly is eligible for the lucrative Inglis race series and VOBIS bonus scheme.



UNITE AND CONQUER X CROSS COURT

NURSERY: This filly comes off the well renowned Kingstar Farm in Denman, an upbringing that will see her have every chance for success on the track.

TRAINER: She will be trained by 2023 Kosciusko winning trainer Matthew Dale out of his state of the art Goulburn facilities and will get every chance.

BONUS: This Filly is eligible for the lucrative Magic Millions race series and BOBS bonus scheme.

NURSERY: This filly comes off a new up and coming boutique farm called Pepper Tree Farm, an upbringing that will see her have every chance for success on the track.

TRAINER: She will be trained by 2023 Kosciusko winning trainer Matthew Dale out of his state of the art Goulburn facilities and will get every chance. We have had great success already with Spirit of Boom as a sire with with Matt including our 2 year old Listed Calaway Gal stakes winner Malaboom.

BONUS: This Filly is eligible for the lucrative Magic Millions race series and QTIS bonus scheme.

INTRODUCING THE BOYS



STAR TURN X BLEUE PEPITE

Why we purchased him?

PEDIGREE: This colt is by the Group I producing sire Star Turn and out of the Fastnet Rock mare Bleue Pepite who has already produced top quality racehorses including the \$400k earner and 6 time winner Ruban Bleu as well as 5 time winner La Defense, she has done a great job at stud to date. Bleue Pepite is a half sister to the Group 3 winning mare Think Bleue.

TYPE: This Colt is extremely well balanced and a showed a fantastic willing workmanlike attitude. He was well put together with plenty of scope. He has all the attributes to make up into a very smart running type.

NURSERY: This colt comes from the Alexia Fraser Bloodstock nursery a young up and coming nursery making a good name for itself in Queensland.

TRAINER: He will be trained by recent \$500k 2yo Magic Millions debutant winning training Chris Anderson out of his state of the art Eagle Farm, Brisbane facilities.

BONUS: This Colt is eligible for the lucrative Magic Millions race series as well as BOTH the BOBS and QTIS bonus scheme.



ANDERS X HAPPY PILGRIM COLT

Why we purchased him?

PEDIGREE: This Colt is by Anders, son of champion sire Not A Single Doubt. Anders first yearlings have been hugely popular at the sale in 2024 with his yearlings averaging \$194k at the January Magic Millions sale making this colt great value. His dam Happy Pilgrim a 3 time winning half sister to Snipzu the Group and Stakes placed dam of 5 runners for 5 winners including 3 individual Group and Stakes horses, most recently the twice Group I placed (Blue Diamond and Inglis Sires Produce) Don Corleone. This Colt is a ½ brother to our very promising 2yo Private Harry, a horse we have a very high opinion of.

TYPE: He is a quality early looking sprinting type and shared a lot of similar characteristics to his brother Private Harry. He had a great action and looks very precocious.

NURSERY: This Colt comes off Rheinwood Pastoral, in recent times Rheinwood have produced the highly exciting colt Libertad a winner of the Group 3 Widden Kindergarten Stakes at 2 and the Group 3 San Domenico (just like Anders) highlighting their ability to produce top class racehorses to compete at the highest level.

TRAINER: He is trained by Nathan Doyle out of the excellent state of the art Newcastle facilities just like his brother.

BONUS: This Colt is eligible for the lucrative Inglis race series and BOBS bonus scheme.



COSMIC FORCE X MISS MARILYN COLT

Why we purchased him?

PEDIGREE: This Colt is by Newgate Farm's exciting first season sire Cosmic Force, already doing a great job with only a handful of runners so far producing 3 individual Stakes horses including the Blue Diamond Prelude Group 3 runner up Stay Focused and Inglis Nursery runner up Beer Baron. His dam Miss Marilyn a winner at II00m is a half sister to the illustrious Group I The Galaxy sprint winning earner of over \$1.7 million Mistegic and Stakes winner of no less than II individual wins Rightson.

TYPE: This Colt was a real standout for us at the sale from the moment we laid eyes on him we knew we were bringing him home. He ticked a lot of boxes for us he moved effortlessly, is so well balanced and oozed class. Every time we saw him he just came out and paraded like the utmost professional.

NURSERY: He was presented at the Inglis Classic sale and comes off the Boutique nursery Riverstone Lodge an upbringing that will see him have every chance for success on the track.

TRAINER: He is trained by Nathan Doyle out of the excellent state of the art Newcastle facilities just like his brother.

BONUS: This Colt is eligible for the lucrative Inglis race series and BOBS bonus scheme.



MICROPHONE X MIRAMARE

Why we purchased him?

PEDIGREE: This Colt is by the exciting young sire Microphone, Champion 2 year old in Australia 2018-2019, a Group I winning 2 year old and one of the fastest sons of Champion sire Exceed and Excel. He dam Miramare is by one of Australasia's leading broodmare sires of all time and multiple Champion NZ sire O'Reilly. She is regally bred being a Full sister to Group I winning sprinter Shamexpress.

TYPE: He is an extremely well balanced colt that moves with swagger and has a bombproof attitude, everything he does he seems to do with the utmost of ease. He is a beautiful specimen of a horse one that oozes quality.

NURSERY: This colt comes off a relatively new up and coming boutique farm called in the Southern highlands with a focus on real quality rather than numbers in B2B Thoroughbreds, the breeders had that much faith in this colt they retained a 25% share in him.

TRAINER: This colt will be trained by Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott out of the historic Tulloch Lodge stables Sydney and will have every chance.

BONUS: This Colt is eligible for the lucrative Magic Millions race series and BOBS bonus scheme.



RUSSIAN REVOLUTION X STREET SECRET

PEDIGREE: This colt is by one of Australia's hottest young sires in Russian Revolution, a Group I winner, already a Group I producing stallion and leading first season sire 2021-2022. PEDIGREE: This Colt is by Spirit of Boom, one of Queensland's leading sires a producer of Group I winner and stallion Jonker as well 22 individual stakes winners. He is out of the well bred Zabeel mare Steflara who has done a fantastic job at stud to date producing 5 runners to the track for 5 winners including the Group 3 Belle of the Turf runner up Pleiades. A pedigree littered with black type, herself a half sister to Squalls the dam of recent Group I Flight Stakes winner Tropical Squall.

TYPE: He was a fantastic physical, well proportioned and used himself very well. He was very well balance and tractable a real athlete. He had a fantastic willing attitude.

NURSERY: This colt comes off one of Queensland's very best nurseries the very same nursery we secured Malaboom from in Eureka Stud.

TRAINER: This colt will also be trained by Matthew Dale just like Malaboom, out of his state of the art Goulburn facilities. We have had great success already with Spirit of Boom as a sire when trained by Matt with our 2 year old Listed Calaway Gal stakes winner Malaboom.

BONUS: This Colt is eligible for the lucrative Magic Millions race series and QTIS bonus scheme.



CAPITALIST X SECRET AGENDA

Why we purchased him?

PEDIGREE: We are delighted to have secured this regally bred colt by the Group I Golden Slipper and Magic Millions 2 year old Classic winner Capitalist, already a Group I producing sire, he is out of the Not a Single Doubt Group I 7 time winning mare Secret Agenda an earner of \$1.5 million herself. She is already a producer of one to race a winner at his only start to date. His pedigree is littered with early 2 year old black type with his dam Secret Agenda being a half sister to no less than 4 individual stakes horses including Tutta La Vita and Stellar Pauline.

TYPE: As a type this Colt is beautifully put together, a real imposing type and has a powerful hind end. He is a very well balanced and athletic type.

NURSERY: He comes off the well renowned Cressfield Stud a producer of quality year in year out including the likes of Onemorenomore, Clearly Innocent and Headwater to name just a few.

TRAINER: He will be trained by Nathan Doyle in Newcastle where he will get every chance.

BONUS: This Colt is eligible for the lucrative Magic Millions race series and BOBS bonus scheme.



GET TO KNOW

The owner for the month of February is Greg Hayes. Greg has owned racehorses for a number of years and has a share in the very exciting 2yo filly, Queens Rhapsody, who recently stepped out at the trials.



QUESTION TIME

- Q- How did you get the initial interest in horse racing?
- A- Coming from a family who owned and trained greyhounds, was probably the influence. But I was always into the horses, my first share was in my early 20s.
- Q- What has been your personal favourite racing moment as an owner?
- A- My first winner, after shares in a dozen or so horses over the years, a horse called Palasport won, my bad luck had finally run out (haven't looked back since).
- Q- Best race you have ever seen?
- A-Bonecrusher and Our Waverley Star (go and watch the replay).
- Q- If you could own any horse of any era, who? And why?
- A- Might and Power 1997 Caulfield and Melbourne cup double, he was a front runner that was always hard to get past. Biased as I had the running cups double at 100/I.
- Q- One meeting or racecourse you would love to attend?
- A- Everest Day, in a function room (now that's being spoilt).



Q- Having owned horses for a number of years, why would you recommend people get involved in racehorse ownership in Australia?

A- Obviously, the prize money is second to none here, but it's the people you meet, whether they are in your horse or in a different horse, you are forming relationships, then you're taking phone numbers and texting each other good luck on race days.

Q- If you could invite 3 people to dinner, dead or alive, who would you choose?

A- Tommy Raudonikis (one tough footy player), Peter V'landys (love his foresight), and Bart Cummings (some of his one-liners, the most famous one, cost you nothing for patience).

Q- What would be your advice to someone new looking to join a syndicate and get involved? A- I now have shares in five horses at the moment, say I can afford IO% in a horse, my recommendation is to have 4 shares at 2.5%, that way you don't have all your eggs in one basket and you're going to have an interest throughout the year. Then invest once a year, so you have your next yearlings coming through.

Q- As a first-time owner with Kurrinda Bloodstock, why would you recommend someone to become an owner with us?

A- Just plain honesty about your horses, they are very transparent. The updates, newsletters, and the episodes on the podcasts with interviews of jockeys, trainers, etc., provide an insight into who they are.
