A DIME APPROACH

1/1 Hanging Rock 1600m B58 3rd

A Dime Approach stepped out for his first start for new trainer Mitch Freedman at the iconic Hanging Rock.

We weren't expecting too much given that 'Dime' will be suited over more ground and more fitness.

If anyone has seen a vision of Hanging Rock, a large portion of the track is actually obstructed by trees. Fortunately one of our owners was on track and able to report back to us after the race. A Dime Approach's last 400m was the best part of his race and we're pleased that he was able to rattle home for 3rd

BOSTON ROCKS

4/1 Randwick 1100m B78 3rd

From a wide draw Boston jumped OK and was forced 3 wide towards the back of the field. He eventually found cover as the field bunched on the turn. Boston ran on strongly beaten only 1.7 lengths to a horse that covered much less ground

PRIVATE HARRY

4/1 Sunshine Coast 1100m Sunlight Slot Race 1st

Private Harry jumped well and was able to get into a good position one out one back. Ash Morgan began to quicken and was eyeballing the leader by the 500metre mark.

By the 300m Harry was a length in front and the race was over.

In the words of Racecaller Mitch Manners "look at him go, Harry, Private Harry won the Sunlight, far to good for Lady of Camelot and Arabian Summer".

Lady of Camelot is the reigning Golden Slipper winner and Arabian Summer is also a stakes performer with over \$1.2 Million prizemoney

A DIME APPROACH 19/I Benalla 2100 B58 1st

A Dime Approach was 2nd up over 2100m. sent out at \$7.50 on the SP.

Something interesting to note is that Victorian staying races are typically run at much slower tempo than Queensland staying races. After jumping well 'Dime' led easily and controlled the race.

a 10 out of 10 ride by Blaike McDougall, A Dime Approach led wire to wire to notched his first win for over a year.

SUPER NORWEST 25/I RANDWICK 1200 Tab Highway 6th

After a few jump outs at home, Super Norwest returned from a long spell and will be targeting the Country Championships this prep. She jumped well so Tim Clark pushed her in a forward position on an extremely fast pace. As they say, you can't burn the candle at both ends and this ultimately caused her to fade to a gallant 6th, just over 3 lengths.

BOSTON ROCKS 25/I RANDWICK 1200 B78 6th

Coming off 2 impressive placings so far this campaign, Boston drew a good gate and a nice firm track. We were optimistic for another good result.

After jumping OK Tim Clarke appeared a bit confused whether to go forward or back, and by doing neither got caught in an awkward position. Boston was clipped by another horse causing two Jockeys to fall. One riderless horse did his best to impede Boston on the turn and it what Matt Dale later described "an absolute mess" of a race, Boston did well to only be beaten 1.6 lengths
