8/2 Randwick 1200m - 5th

Super Norwest was 2nd up after a gut-busting 1st up run. After jumping well, Jockey Ash Morgan took advantage of her handy position and slowly nursed her into the lead. Super turned for home in front at was a length in front at the 400M. Only 1.1 lengths.

Matt Dale was incredibly impressed with Ash's ride and also Super Norwest's run leading into the Country Champions Qualifier at Nowra

A DIME APPROACH

174/2 Terang 2150m - 3rd

The Mitch Freedman stable is flying at the moment. A Dime Approach notched up a notable 3rd in the Terang High weights carrying 70kg on the day. Mitch is doing a wonderful job with the gelding and he is knocking on the door for another win

22/2 Rosehill 1100m - 1st

A number of keen owners were on course to enjoy Boston's 5th win from just 16 starts. A master ride from Ash Morgan to keep Boston well balanced off a hot tempo and run on strongly for the win. When Ash was interviewed by Channel 7's Emma Freedman post race on his relationship with Kurrinda Bloodstock, he responded "I love the colours, they are very lucky..."

SUPER NORWEST

23/2 Nowra 1400m - 14th

This race had been the target all along and Super Norwest was well found in the betting market at \$4.20 on the SP.

She jumped well but in a large field and in a scrimmage on a first tight turn, Super galloped on herself. This caused her to take off on fear and in what looked like an easy lead she faded halfway up the straight and was eased down.

Some early winners and why they were so popular

- 1957 Todman - winner of 10 from 12 including the Golden Slipper by 8 lengths. Always partnered by Jockey Neville Selwood. Went on to sire future Golden Slipper winners Eskimo Prince and Sweet Embrace
- 1960 Sky High - By same influential sire Star Kingdom, Sky High won 29 from 55 starts including the Golden Slipper and VRC Derby in the same year, multiple Lightning stakes, the 1961 Epsom Derby and many more majors
- 1970 Baguette - The first horse to win the 2YO Triple Crown. The Dam Sire is - you guessed it - Star Kingdom
