After jumping well Nick Heywood pressed forward to take the lead, Nick balanced at the 400m and asked the horse to respond, however he unfortunately suffered yet another pelvic injury. We are currently attending to the rehabilitation of Puzzle Dragon and he will be re-homed to an equestrian centre for his next chapter.

Son Of Eureka

3/3 Bathurst 1200m - 2nd

An excellent second up performance to run 2nd. Just was no match for the \$1.60 favourite Ischyros

Boston Rocks

7/3 Moonee Valley 1200m - 1st

Coming off a last start Saturday win at Rosehill, Boston was rock hard fit and was placed well by Matt Dale in the sprint final at Moonee Valley Friday night meeting. Jamie Mott booked to ride was able to get into a forward position. Boston was then invited to a new \$750,000 slot race at Toowoomba named 'King of the Mountain', 28/3 however due to heavy rain and heavy track was scratched and was sent for a spell.

16/3 Sunshine Coast 1000m - 3rd

In Stuarts pre race he suggested our mare was very fresh and sharp, so rather than run in a trial, why not run in a race and aim to pick up some prize money at the same time. Ultimatley she ran a terrific 2.1 length 3rd and im sure many owners paid for their Sunday night Thai takeaway with an each way bet at \$51 SP

Stern Reminder

16/3 Coonamble 1100m - 3rd

Quite literally the next race on Sky Thoroughbred Central was a Coonamble Super Maiden corresponding with the Country Championship Qualifier day. Our Winning Rupert Gelding stepped out for his first ever start for trainer Cody Morgan. It was a fantastic debut finishing only 1.5L behind a stakes placed filly.
