Half Crown was 6 weeks between runs and was found to over race and get caught 4 and 5 wide unfortunately, this was a pen job and a forget run. He is currently spelling and will head down to Mitch Freedman in Melbourne next preparation.



## Hidden Motive 7/6 Royal Randwick II00m - Ist

Hidden Motive took the next step in his preparation and won his final race of that prep. He has since spelled for two weeks and is now back in full work.



Queens Rhapsody 17/6 Haweskbury I300M - 5<sup>th</sup>

Queens Rhapsody was disappointing to the eye but overall the way the race was run and being caught three wide no cover and 4 and five wide on the turn she was unfortunately no hope of winning from where she was positioned. A forget run.

7/6 Royal Randwick II00m - 5<sup>th</sup>

Satin Stiletto jumped well and then restrained for reasons we still are unsure about, she ran a gallant 5<sup>th</sup> after being trapped wide the entire, a complete forget run unfortunately.

21/6 Royal Randwick 1200m - 3rd

Satin again jumped well and Braith elected to take up the lead, she wobbled slightly on the home turn and gave up the rail where the eventual winner came. It was a terrific run, she has now since gone to the paddock where she will have 6 weeks off and then she will come back to focus on the highways.



Super Nor west 14/6 Rosehill Gardens 1400M - Ist

Super Norwest jumped well and Braith elected to position her in just behind the speed with cover, she settled great with the addition of ear muffs. She fought hard and really wanted this win with her ears pinned back, it was a 10/10 from Braith.

Super Norwest 28/6 Rosehill Gardens 1400M - 7<sup>th</sup>

Super Norwest jumped well from a tricky gate yet again, unfortunately this time Braith was unable to slot in and get cover. Super Norwest travelled three deep with no cover the enitre race and still showed the oudacity to still fight to the line and get beat 3.4L What this showed us asa team is that Super Norwest is very competive in open benchmark grade on a Saturday so very exciting moving forward.


